

## The facts..



#### SETTING - OVERVIEW:

The settings reflect the tense and delicate mood from the stage production. It also helps to show the emotional journey of the characters, as well as adding to their isolation and sense of them being in their own world through the bare, open and vast landscapes chosen.

The locations also reflect the development of the relationship of the characters, from their initial apprehension towards each other, to them becoming closer and more intimate. The film starts in very vast, isolated settings and progresses to more intimate locations.

## WORKSHEET 1 – SETTING – COMPLETE THE DESCRIPTION & CONTRIBUTION:

#### PROLOGUE:

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Deserted streets and a graveyard with an overcast sky and drizzling rain.

- The empty streets give a sense of isolation.
- The graveyard suggests she has lost someone close to her.
- The overcast sky and rain create a bleak atmosphere.





#### THE BEGINNING:

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Two locations. A vast open field with long grass which moves in the wind. The hill in the distance becomes the second setting. A barren cliff top with uninterrupted views.

- The environments appear infinite, reinforcing the characters isolation and enhancing the lonely mood.
- The vast space also complements the choreographic intention of the dancers using as much space as possible between them whilst remaining in contact.

#### **MOVING CLOSER:**

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

A field, looking towards a misty valley with hills in the background.

#### INTERPRETATION/CONTRIBUTION:

The grass in front of the dancers makes it seem less barren that the cliff top, although it is still isolated and the mist gives a sombre atmosphere.





## SECTIONS..



#### FLOW ONE:

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

- A dense forest, with shafts of light coming through the trees. INTERPRETATION/CONTRIBUTION:
- The more enclosed performance signifies the relationship becoming more intimate and suggests that time has passed by.



## SECTIONS..



#### **KNEELING:**

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

A field at dusk, with long grass surrounding them.

- Contrasts the earlier vast setting and seems more intimate.
- Reinforces the idea that they are growing closer and shutting themselves off from the world.

#### **FLOW TWO:**

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

- Three location: a cliff top, a quarry and the field where they've been in the previous section.
- Shifts rapidly between the three locations.

- The quarry seems secluded yet also is a harsh landscape reflecting the tension in the relationship.
- The locations mixed together could suggest a play between reality (in the field where they've just been) and an internal struggle (in the oppressive quarry landscape.)


#### **FLOOR:**

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

Returns to the field seen in 'KNEELING' with the dancers in a small clearing.

#### INTERPRETATION/CONTRIBUTION:

The setting appears much more intimate as they are surrounded by the grass and are very close to the ground. This intimate setting is complemented by the dimmer lighting.
