



Within Her Eyes was filmed OUTSIDE and uses NATURAL LIGHT. The film was shot in Wales in mostly grey, gloomy weather, which gives it a sombre atmosphere. In post-production the film was given a slightly dark undertone enhancing the mood further.

The light gradually fading and becoming darker as the dance progresses reflects.....

The passing of time in the relationship and also adds to the sense of intimacy as the characters become closer towards the end of the piece.

DESCRIPTION:

Natural light – Dull and dreary.

INTERPRETATION/CONTRIBUTION:

Complements the deserted streets and drizzling rain to create a sombre atmosphere and emphasise her isolation.

THE BEGINNING/MOVING CLOSER:

DESCRIPTION:

Natural light with an overcast sky.

- Adds to the sombre atmosphere and the sense of isolation.
- The time of day is used to suggest the early stage of their relationship.

FLOW ONE:

DESCRIPTION:

- Ratural light.
- The light is blocked by trees si is visibly dimmer.

- Suggests the passing of time as it is becoming dimmer and gradually moving towards night time.
- Adds to the sense of intimacy.

KNEELING:

DESCRIPTION:

- Real light.
- Noticeably dimmer.

INTERPRETATION/CONTRIBUTION:

Suggests it is dusk/night time showing the passing of time.

Researched Enhances the sense that they are growing closer and more

intimate.





FLOW TWO:

DESCRIPTION:



- Creates a tense and dramatic atmosphere.
- Draws the viewer in to really focus on the choreography.

FLOOR:

DESCRIPTION:

- Natural light.
- ≪ Filmed in the evening so very dark.



- Contrasts earlier sections and suggests night time, reflecting the passing of time and the possible end of the relationship.
- Complements the costume. His dark clothing makes him blend into the darkness. Her lighter costume can be seen more clearly which emphasises its light and fragile texture, reflecting her character.

OVERVIEW:

- The accompaniment of the work is an original score composed by SEYMOUR MILTON, which fuses electronic and classical sounds. It was created in collaboration with JAMES COUSINS alongside the choreography.
- There are two clear halves that reflect the structure of the choreography and the narrative and TWO CLIMAXES that correlate to the end of both FLOW ONE & FLOW TWO.
- The accompaniment helps to communicate the dark and sombre atmosphere and adds tension but is also delicate to reflect the fragile relationship. The score uses strings that are very emotive, as well as piano, which gives a fragile and tentative quality.
