Sex and Relationships Education/Staying Safe

At All Saints Academy, we are committed to our vision of “Living Well Together with Dignity, Faith and Hope” and this shapes our programme of Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education (PSHCE) and our Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural Education (SMSC). As part of our delivery, we offer a programme of Sex and Relationships Education (SRE) for all students. We are planning to deliver the Year 7 programme through Wednesday P5 Enrichment time starting on Wednesday 9th January 2019 and would like to give you an overview of what the programme will entail.

The focus of this year’s programme is very much on helping our students understand their changing bodies and changing emotions. The five sessions will cover:-
