

This year's Prom will be held at Luton Hoo Walled Garden on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2019 between 7.00pm and 11.00pm. It is expected that all students will arrange their own transport to, and from, the venue. Academy staff will be in attendance at the Prom, but supervision is also provided by the staff at the venue. Tickets will be on sale shortly at Student Reception, priced at £35.00 and the ticket includes food and entertainment. Students who have achieved a place in the top two Progress 8 Leagues will be rewarded with vouchers that can be used to offset the cost of their ticket and they should see Mr O'Rourke to discuss this. **Tickets must be purchased by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May so that we can make all of the arrangements with the venue.**

We very much want all students to be a part of this very important "rite of passage" event but we also know that students have to earn the right to celebrate with us. The expectations are that all students will attend every examination without prompting or chasing and that they will all have gained fewer than **5 behaviour points** and have attendance of above **96% from 25<sup>th</sup> March until the end of their time with us**. It is also worth noting that we retain the right to remove invitations to the Prom at any time due to behaviour issues in school.

We are looking forward to another excellent Prom and look forward to celebrating with you all.
