## **Booking Appointments Through Edulink**

Bookings can be made for a parents' evening by logging in, clicking on the Parents' Evening menu icon and then clicking on the event. You will then see a table (desktop/tablet version) of all the teachers you can make bookings for along the top and slot times down the side.

To make a booking for a teacher just click/tap on an available slot (white) a popup will appear allowing you to enter an optional note to the teacher, when finished click the book button.
