"What if I don't make friends?"


"You probably will even if it is from different years"

"Are teachers strict and nice?"


"Yes they are strict and yes they are nice."

"What happens if you get lost finding your way around your new school and arrive a little late for that lesson, will you be told off?"


"No there are students in school who help you and give you directions for where to go."
