Dear Parent/Carer

We are looking forward to welcoming your son/daughter to All Saints Academy in September. We have been unable to hold transition days and evenings so we felt it would be useful to get in touch with you to let you know the current plan.

Transition

As we have been unable to complete our normal transition days, I have uploaded to our website several videos and documents addressing common questions that you or your son/daughter may have. You can find these under 'Parents & Carers' and then go to 'Year 6 to Year 7 Transition'.

First Day

Assuming there is no change to Government guidance over the summer break, Year 7 will be starting school on Monday 7th September. They should come to the main doors and then they will be directed to the Main Hall so they can be sorted into their new Tutor Groups.

The first hour of the day will be a welcome assembly as well as time in Tutor Groups getting to know each other and the Academy. At the start of every lesson in the first week students will be escorted to the department where the next lesson will take place to minimise anxiety about moving around the school. Please be assured that there will be plenty of staff and students around who will help direct new students if they do not know where they should be.

Students should bring a packed lunch for the first week as they will not yet be set up on the cashless payment system.

If any government advice changes over the summer we will update you as soon as possible.
