- I will **select** a local business, charity or enterprise that I would like to undertake **work experience** with and explain in my 1:1 why I have done this.
- I will take part in activities to help develop my understanding of what jobs are and will be available to me in the future.
- During my 1:1 with my Form Tutor, I will lead the conversation about the ideas that I have and they will help me **understand** what I need to do to help realise my **ambition** and I will identify the key things that my chosen workplace need in a work experience candidate.
- I will expand on the conversation that we had in Year 8 and make sure I come away from my 1:1 with answers to my questions.
- My teachers, from all of my subjects, will continue to explain how an **understanding** of **STEM** can improve my **opportunities** to achieve my career **goals**.
- In all of my **Topics** of learning, there will be a clear **understanding** of how it can support me in my career **development**, I will help realise this and be able to explain to friends, home and other students how my subjects can relate to the world of work.
- Every faculty will organise a different **subject specific speaker** from my Year 7 and 8 speaker to talk to my class about how I could develop a career in that area.
- I will actively participate in assemblies from local employers and other organisations.
- I will choose a career that is different from the one I have discussed in my 1:1 and explain how I could also develop my skillset to achieve this.
- I will take part in the Careers Day and complete my target card.
- During my 1:1 with my **Form Tutor**, I will **select** a local business, charity or enterprise that I would like to undertake **work experience** with and explain in my 1:1 why I have done this.
- During my subject specific speaker sessions my teacher will explain the journey that I might have to take in order to achieve this career.
- I will have my 1:1 with my **Form Tutor** and know that they are someone I can **seek advice from.**
- I will actively engage with my own future and make sure that I am the leader in my career path.
