New Learning



Term 1 – Recording in log book and exploring different media and techniques. Understanding how to record and present written and practical work in your log book. Experiment with a diverse range of media and techniques inspired by contemporary artists and old masters.

Term 2 – Mini independent photography project. Find a photographer who manually edits their work and create a mini project which clearly demonstrates an understanding of their work and an ability to be inspired by their work in your own.

Introduction to coursework project, choosing a concept to explore and researching this in order to form an appropriate response through your own work. Your coursework project should develop from the research you have done and through investigation into artists and techniques.

Term 3 – Coursework and Year 10 final outcome. Developing your concept towards a final outcome which should be refined and reflect your concept.
