When you start at All Saints Academy, you will be given a full set of uniform free of charge. Students will be measured by the company who supply our uniform



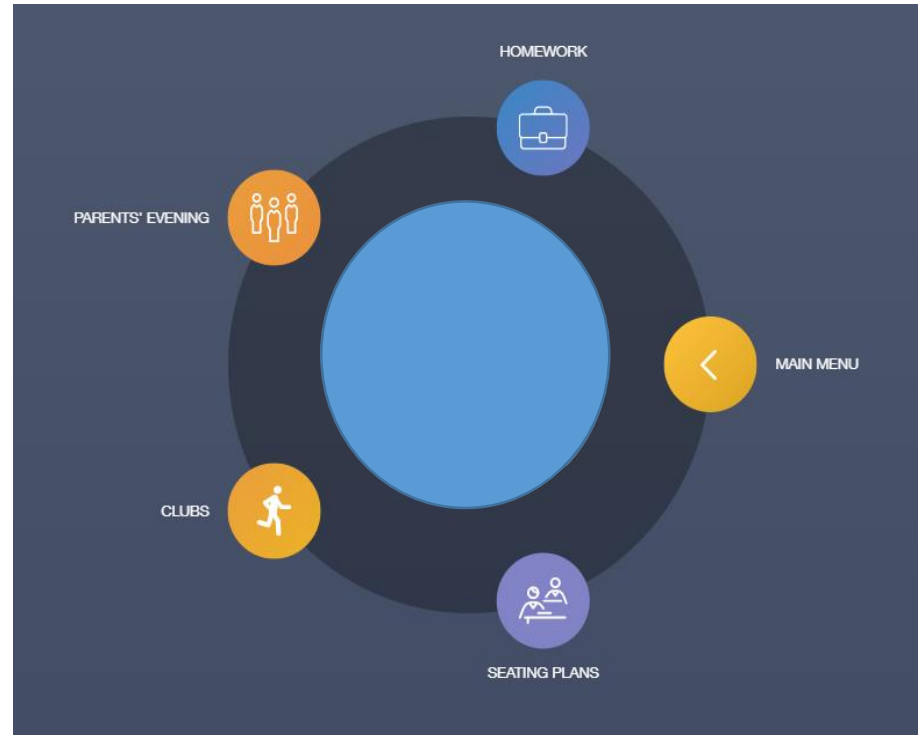
All students will be provided with all the equipment they will need for lessons. If they choose to bring their own pencil case, they can of course do that.



All students at All Saints Academy are provided with an iPad. This is to assist them with their learning, both in school and at home. We expect students to use them responsibly. If they choose not to, the iPad is removed from the student. iPads are given to Year 7 students once they have been at the academy for a few weeks and have settled into a routine.



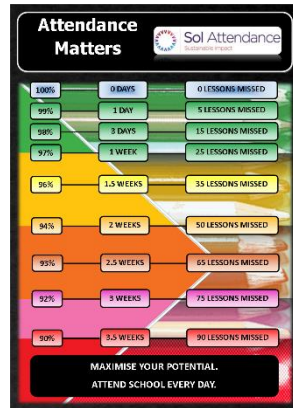
We use a system called 'EduLink' which allows students and parents/carers to find out key information and communicate with the school.



### Attendance

Good attendance to school is vital so that students can learn and make progress. At All Saints Academy, the attendance target is **95% or above.**

By meeting this target, students are ensuring that they are maximising their potential to succeed. They are also then eligible to receive rewards we have in place, that are linked to attendance.



### Phones

At All Saints there is a no mobile phone policy. All students must place their phones in a **Yondr Pouch** on entry to the academy. This closes via a magnetic lock which will stay locked throughout the day. Students can then open their pouch as they leave school at the end of the day. If they forget their pouch they must hand their phone in to staff.



### Learning Agreement

Parents and students will sign a learning agreement that says that you are happy to meet our expectations, while in turn, we ensure your child receives a quality education, enhanced with opportunities of enrichment, to ensure the students leave All Saints Academy as well rounded, happy young adults.



As a school, we pride ourselves on the opportunities that we provide for our students.

There a variety of rewards available to students throughout the school year, these include:

- Reward vouchers worth £5, £10, £20 and £50 for meeting expectations via the '6Ps' and maintaining your attendance.
- Trips to Southend, Whippsnade, the Panto, kite flying and Enrichment Days
- Virtues badges which enable you to jump the lunch queue.

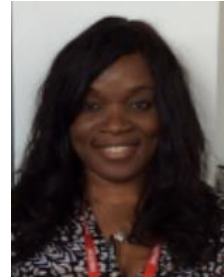
